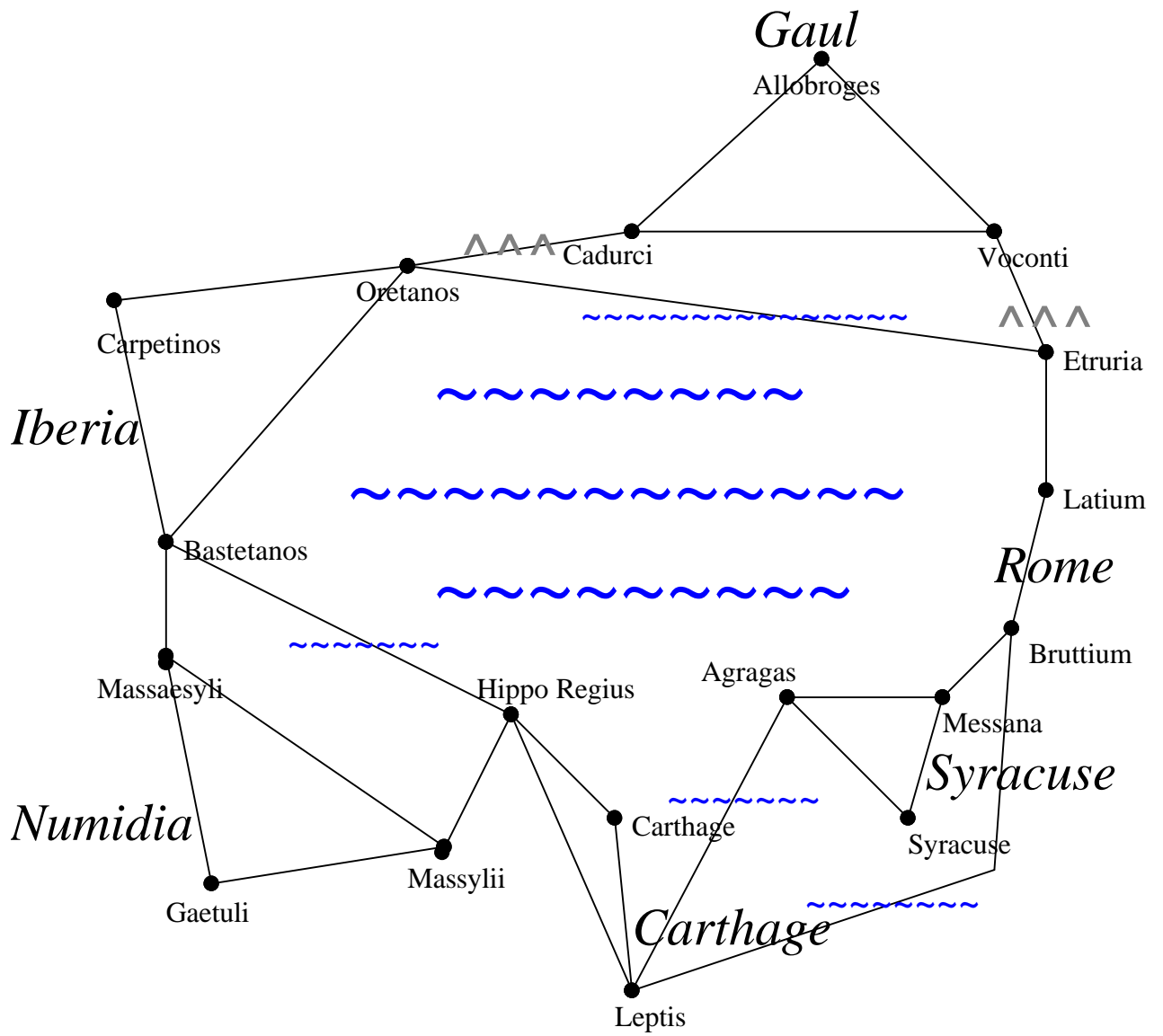


Second Punic War

Map Notes:

The map layout roughly reflects the geography of the western Mediterranean sea hence Italy is long and thin. The province names have been chosen from those that are in approximately the correct geographical position and because the name appeals to me. The names are derived from the following: Rome (Italian provinces), Carthage and Syracuse (city names), Numidia, Spain and Gaul (Tribes). Capitals for Rome, Carthage and Syracuse are the historical ones. Numidia, Spain and Gaul are chosen for reasons of geographical location.

The map denotes both water routes and routes through mountains (i.e. the Alps). Players may elect to employ variant rules for naval warfare and/or passage through mountains.
